



- 1) 84% of the students agree that entire syllabus was covered as per the new NEP syllabus.
- 2) 16% of the students suggest completing the entire syllabus well in advance.







- 1) 87% of the students agree that teachers come with complete preparation for the classes.
- 2) 13% of the students suggest that teachers can prepare well for the classes.







- 1) 81% of the students agree that teachers have good communication skills.
- 2) 19% of the students suggest that teachers can improve their communication skills.







- 1) 89% of the students are happy and satisfied with teachers teaching approach.

- 2) 14% of the students suggest that, evaluation process can be better structured.






- 1) 73% of the students agree that teachers regularly discuss the performance in assignment.
- 2) 27% of the students suggest that, discussion of the performance in assignments can be well organized.






### **Analysis:**


- 1) 68% of the students agree that usually the institute takes active interest in promoting the students to utilize different opportunities and get benefited from it.
- 2) 32% of the students suggest that, the institute can improve better in promoting students to utilize different opportunities.







- 1) 89% of the students agree that teaching and mentoring process of the institute is well established and it helps them to improve overall growth.
- 2) 11% of the students suggest that, the institute can improve the teaching and mentoring process.






- 1) 79% of the students agree with the provision of multiple opportunities to learn and grow.

- 3) 5% students are in neutral of provision of multiple opportunities to learn and grow.







- 1) 81% of the students agree that teachers inform them about expected competencies, course outcomes and program outcomes.
- 2) 19% of the students suggest that teachers can inform them about expected competencies, course outcomes and program outcomes on regular bases.







- 1) 88% of the students agree that mentors perform necessary follow-up of assigned task of students.
- 2) 12% of the students suggested to take necessary follow-up of assigned work.






- 1) 94% of the students agree that teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.

### **Analysis:**


1) 74% of the students agree that teachers are able to identify student's weaknesses through tests, seminars, group discussions and help them to overcome them.




### **Analysis:**


- 1) 80% of the students agree that institution makes efforts to engage students in themonitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.

- 3) 8% students are in neutral of monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process


16. The institute/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.







- 1) 86% of the students agree that the institute/ teachers use student centric methods for enhancing learning experiences.

19. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching






