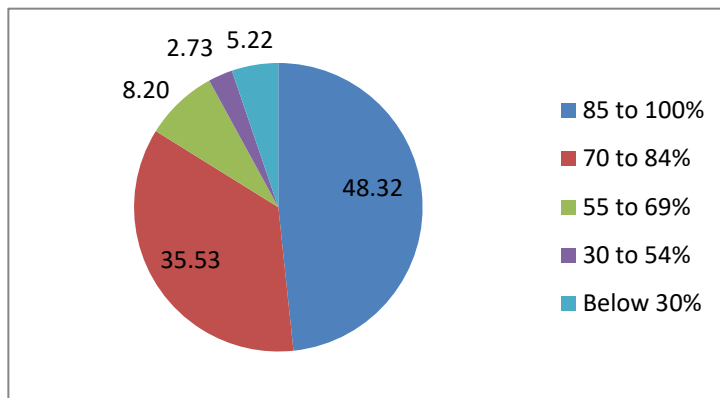

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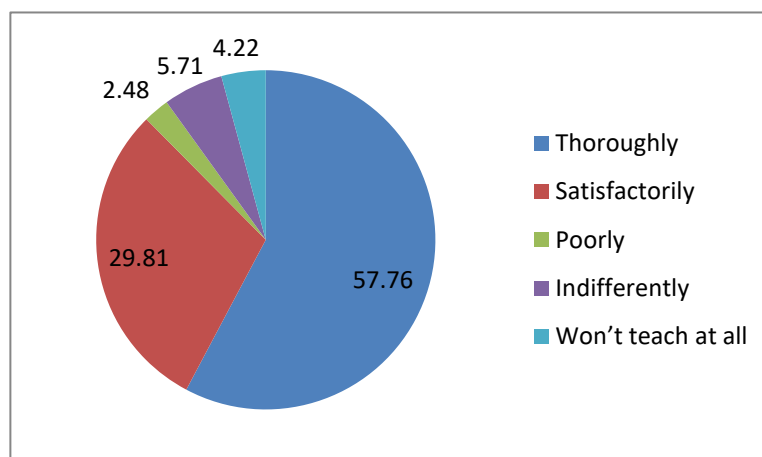


Analysis:

3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?

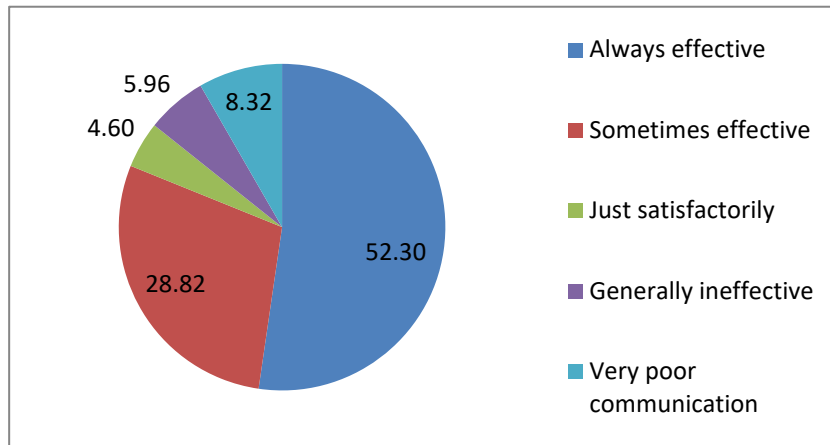

4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as

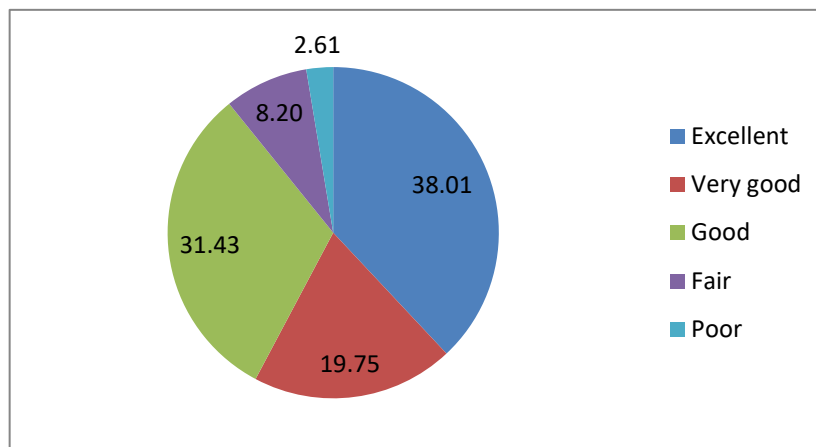

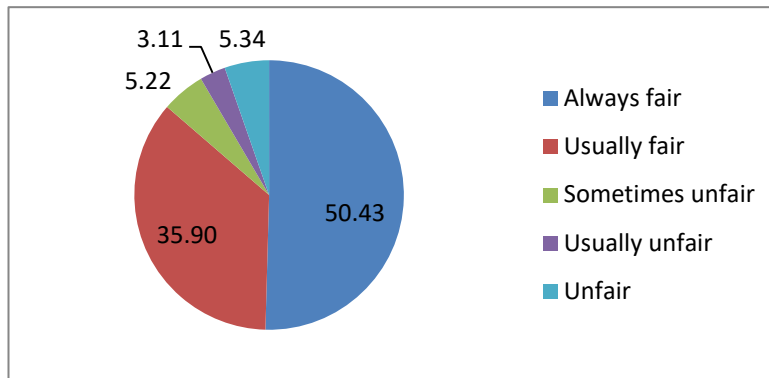


Analysis:

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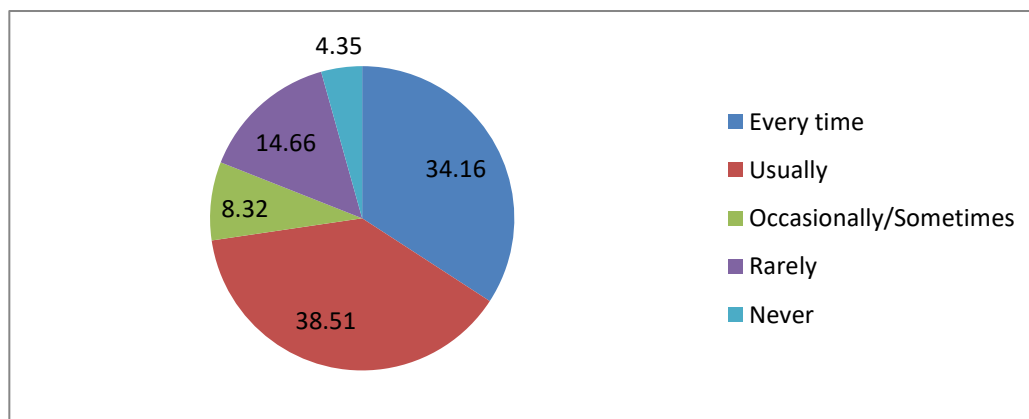


Analysis:

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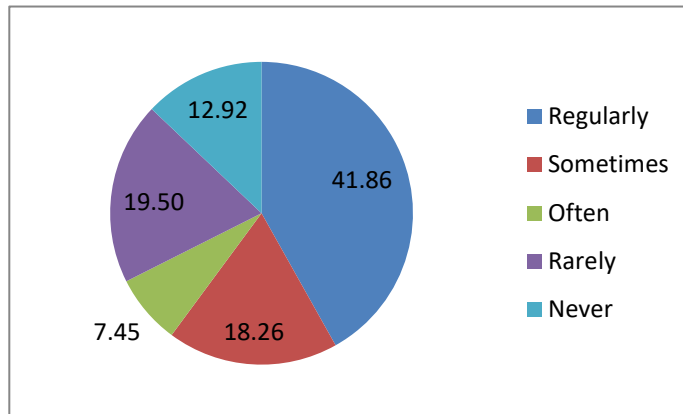


Analysis:

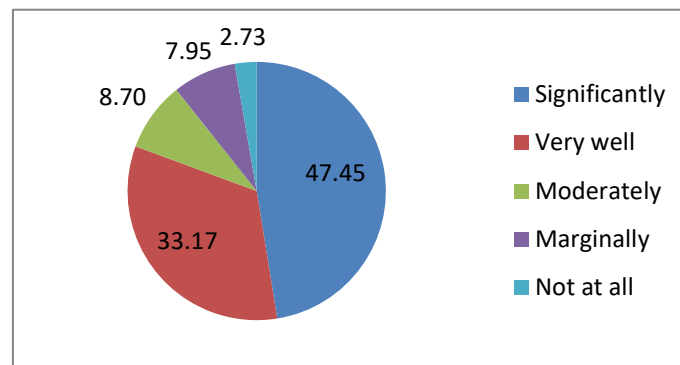


Analysis:

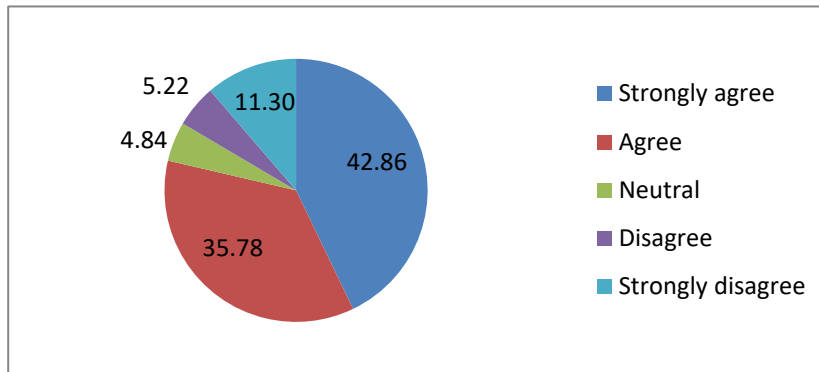


Analysis:

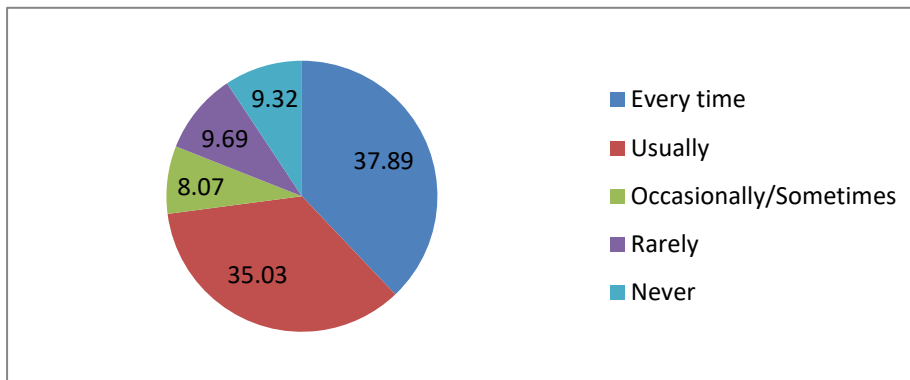


Analysis:

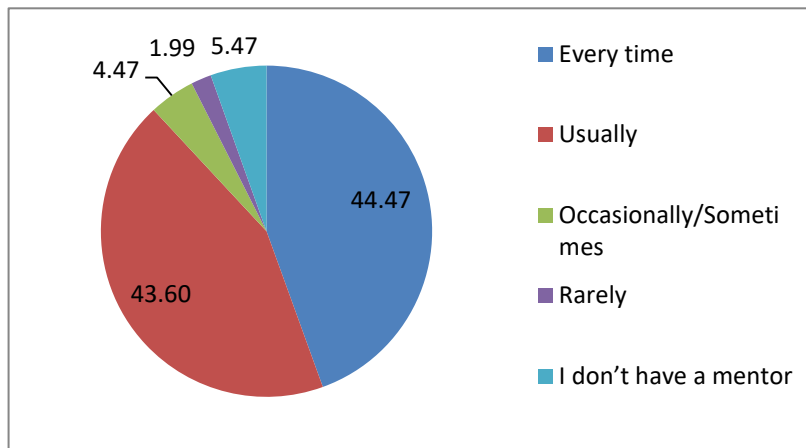


Analysis:

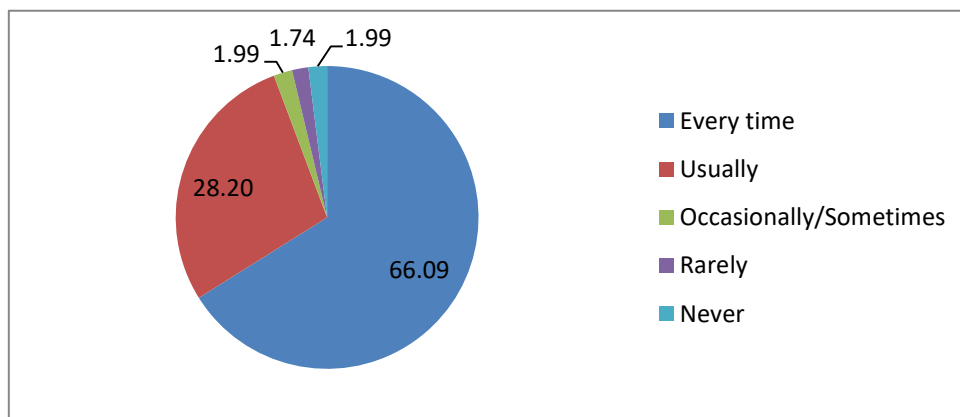


Analysis:

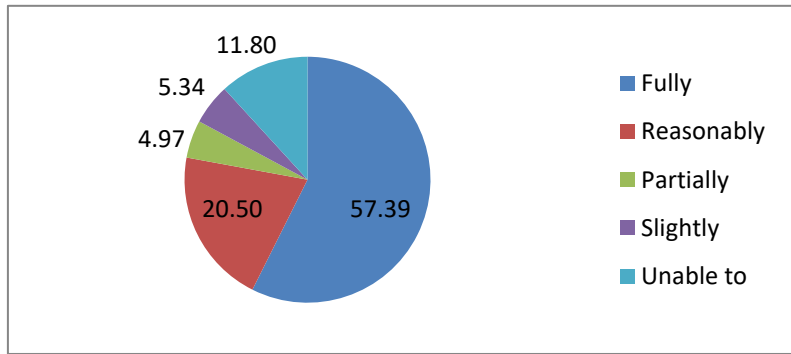


Analysis:

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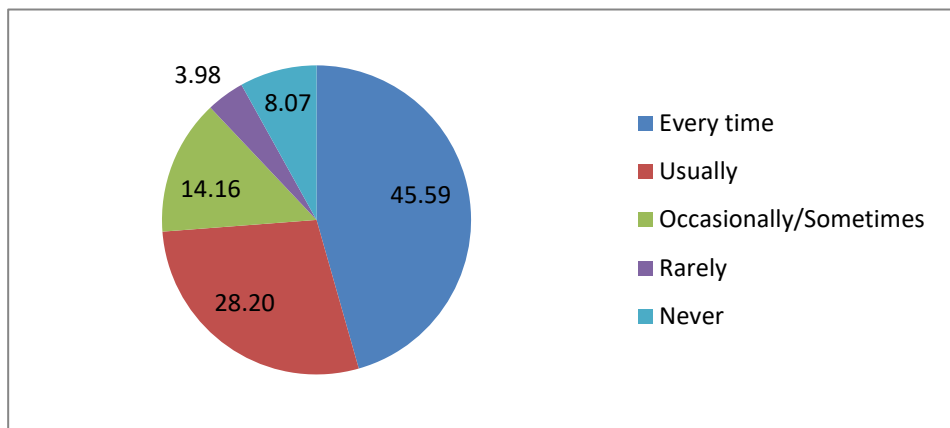


Analysis:

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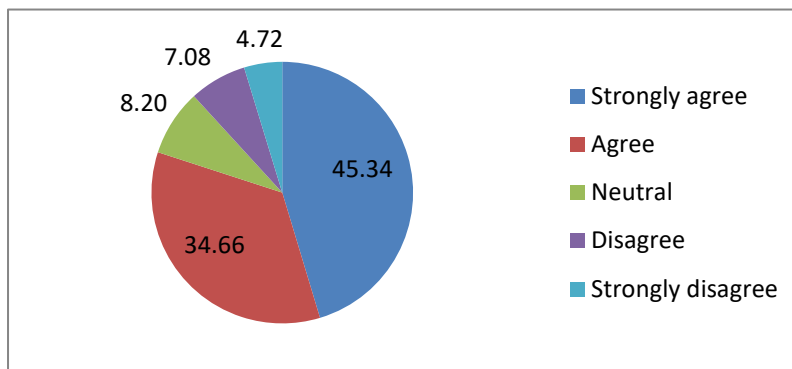


Analysis:

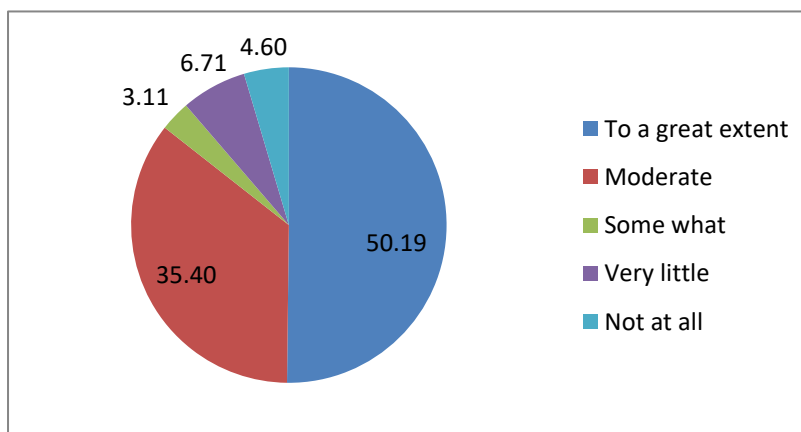


Analysis:

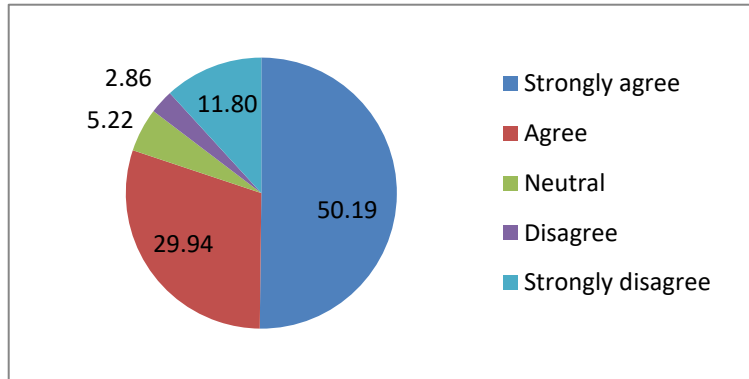


Analysis:

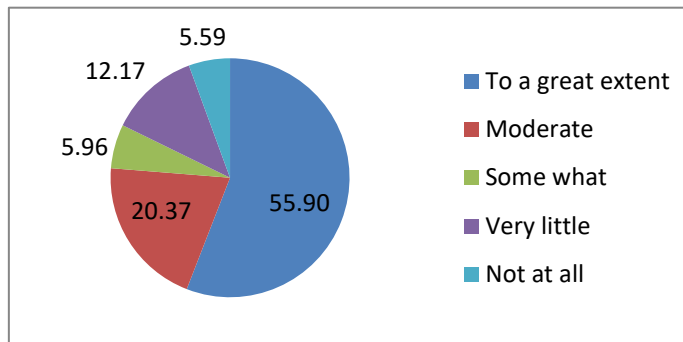


Analysis:

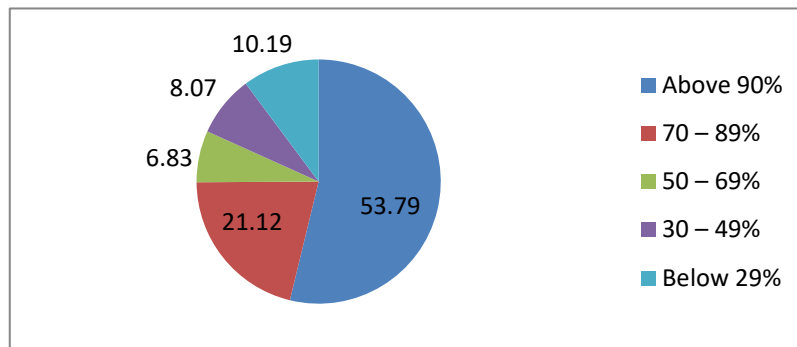


Analysis:

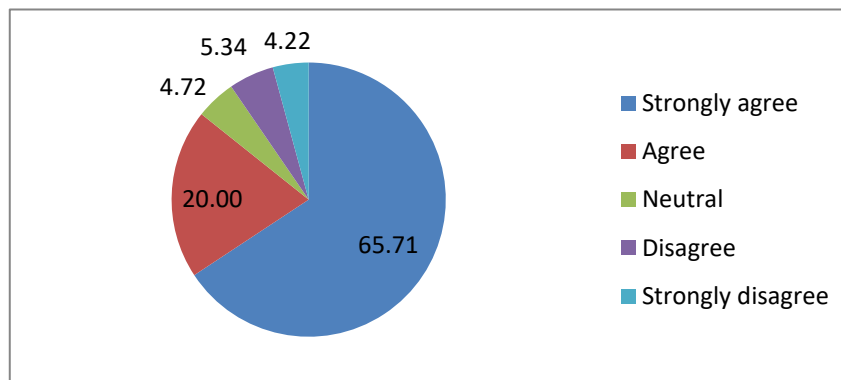


Analysis:
