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







- 1) 88% of the students agree that teachers come with complete preparation for the classes.
- 2) 12% of the students suggest that teachers can improve their preparation for the classes.






- 1) 76% of the students agree that teachers have good command over communication skills.
- 2) 24% of the students suggest that teachers can improve their communication skills.




- 1) 93% of the students are happy and satisfied with teachers teaching approach.

- 2) 41% of the students suggest that, discussion of the performance in assignments can be well organized.




1) 89% of the students agree that teaching and mentoring process of the institute is well established and it helps them to improve overall growth.




2) 11% of the students suggest that, the institute can make improvements in teaching and mentoring process.

- 3) 22% students are in neutral of provision of multiple opportunities to learn and grow.







- 1) 90% of the students agree that teachers inform them about expected competencies, course outcomes and program outcomes.


- 1) 72% of the students agree that mentors perform necessary follow-up of assigned task of students.

- 2) 24% of the students suggest that teachers can improve in identifying student'sweaknesses and help them to overcome them.




